In paris, dada took on a literary emphasis under one of its founders, the poet tristan tzara. most notable among the numerous dada pamphlets and reviews was littérature (published 1919–24), which contained writings by andré breton, louis aragon, philippe soupault, paul Éluard, and georges ribemont-dessaignes. Introduction "modern art" is a broad term which refers to art produced during the years 1870-1970. some historians prefer to limit "modern art" to the 20th century, but, it is more customary to take impressionism as the starting point, while the 1960s are usually seen as the transition between "modern art" and its "art is the fatal net which catches these strange moments on the wing like mysterious butterflies, fleeing the innocence and distraction of common men." (1924). museum of modern art, new york. by andre masson. what is automatism? in fine art, the term "automatism" most often refers to a technique of subconscious drawing in which the artist allows his unconscious mind to take control. The term "abstract expressionism" was first used in germany in connection with rusian artist wassily kandinsky in 1919 (referencing the german expressionists with their anti-figurative aesthetic), but later became more commonly associated with post-wwii american art. alfred barr was the first Man ray was one of the leading artists of the avant garde of 1920s and 1930s paris. a key figure in the dada and surrealist movements, his works spanned various media, including film. he was a leading exponent of the cinéma pur, or "pure cinema," which rejected such "bourgeois" conceits as Western painting - modern: the term modern art has come to denote the innovating and even revolutionary developments in western painting and the other visual arts from the second half of the 19th century through the first half of the 20th. it embraces a wide variety of movements, styles, theories, and attitudes, the modernity of which resides This is an experiment in visual display to help people appreciate the role of the nodes as proxy agents. the nodes act on behalf of planets (1) with which they're associated, (2) by which they're aspected, (3) whose sidereal sign they occupy, and (4) whose nakshatra they occupy, in descending order of effect.

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
